I believe there are three major judgments in the New Testament: that of believers, the nations, and that of sinners. Some of these will have references and others not. For instance, where do the Judgment Seat of Christ or the Great White Throne judgments take place? We know it is not on earth. Is it in Heaven?, possibly, or in space?, possibly. We just do not know, and for that reason I have written some in italics.
