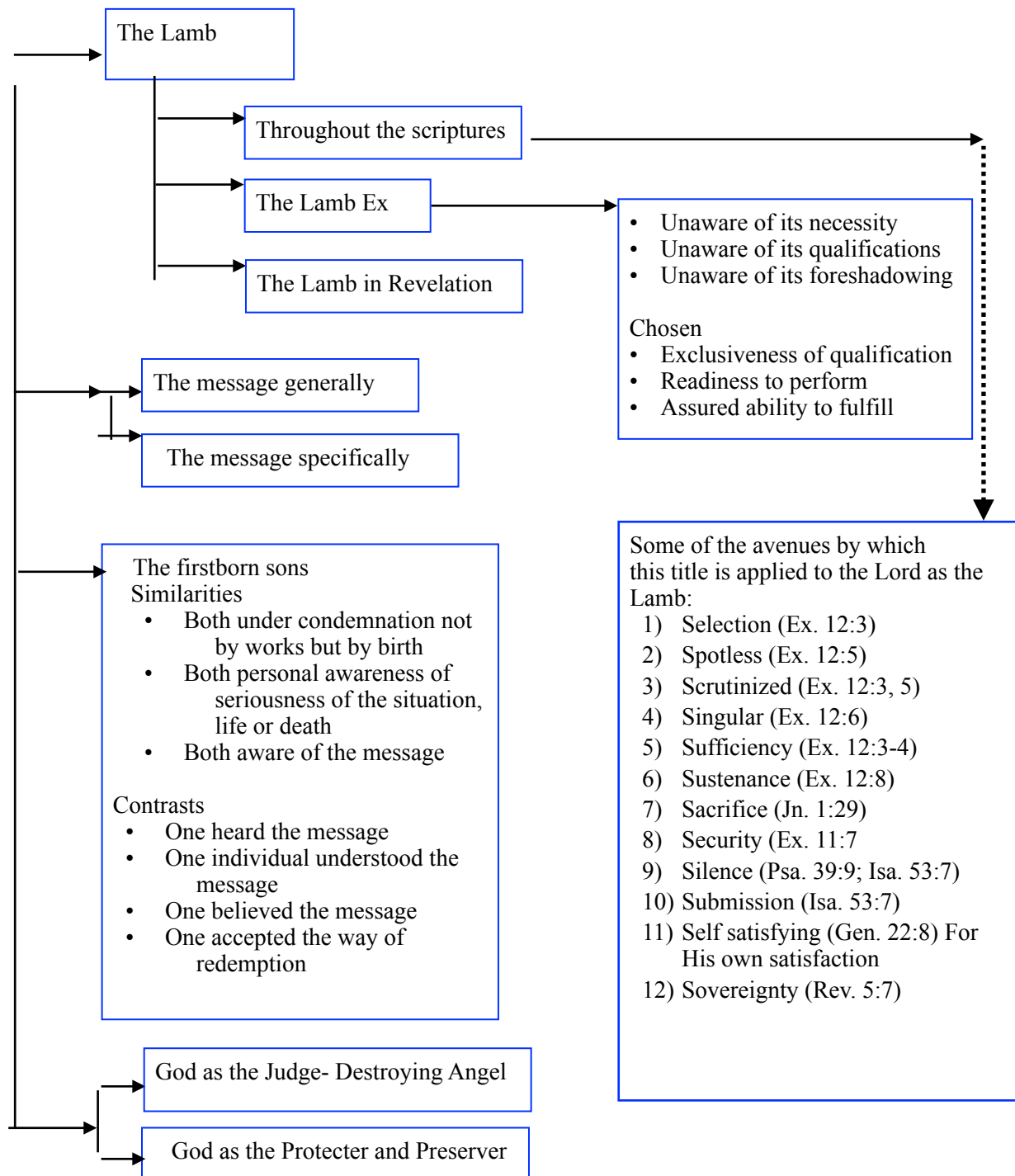

### Exodus - The Passover Itemized - Part 1

When the Lord cried: “Not my will, but thine, be done” and the work of redemption moved forward, it manifests what God was not willing to do: (Lk. 22:42)

- Ignore His own perfection of Holiness universally( lower His standard of perfection)
- Let His own eternal purposes be nothing but empty dreams
- Set aside Christ’s eternal glorification on earth and Heaven
- Permit Satan to have dominion and let sin run rampantly throughout the ages and universe
- Let the sinner die without hope and be in Hell - no redemption, justification, reconciliation
- Let a body of a man totally devoted to Him be shamed and mocked without recompense

Observations:

- a) Lamb in Ex. 12 and Rev. 5
  - i) Sacrificial - Sovereign
    - 1. His superiority and supremacy - Heb. 1 etc.
  - ii) Victim - Victorious
    - 1. Hast redeemed us to God by Thy blood (Rev. 5:9)
  - ii) Slain - resurrected
    - 1. In the power of an endless life (Heb. 7:16)
    - 2. Alive forever more (Rev. 1:18)
